

Austrian Reining Futurity 2021 begins on August 17

With great anticipation, but also trepidation, the reining scene looks forward to the upcoming show season. Will all shows be able to take place, and if so, under what conditions? Last year, host and show manager Helmut Schulz proved that it is possible to put on a great reining show even in Corona times with the Austrian Reining Futurity 2020. For this year, he is once again determined to offer a top class show with the Austrian Reining Futurity 2021 with the best conditions for horse and rider. For this, Helmut Schulz will pull out all the stops in his usual manner, although there are still many imponderables. For example, the final prize money has not yet been determined.

What is certain is that the Austrian Reining Futurity and NRHA Show will start one day earlier, just like last year. The reining highlight, which has been one of the top 25 reining events in the world for years, will start on August 17 with the Ancillary classes. On August 18, the first Futurity classes for 3- and 4-year-old horses will follow. The Austrian Futurity is open to all horses and will feature four levels each in Open and Non Pro. All classes are NRHA approved. In the Futurity classes, both 3 and 4 year old horses can be shown either double handed on snaffle bit or hackamore or single handed on bit. For the benefit of the Austrian Reining Futurity there will again be a stallion service auction with top-class stallions.

But not only the Futurity classes are very popular with the international reining community. Also the Ancillary classes are in demand, especially the well endowed Bronze Trophy Open and Non Pro.
