

## **Western Star HD starts Show Season 2022 at Wiener Neustadt**

### **Highlights: Austrian Reining Futurity and Austrian Maturity**

Western Star HD Quarter Horses in Wiener Neustadt starts the show season 2022 in April with two shows. The kick off will be from April 1 till 3 with the ARHA Challenge, followed by the NRHA/ARHA Easter Show from April 15 to 17. The announcements are already online at [www.awa.at](http://www.awa.at). Before that, host Helmut Schulz welcomes riders for his Reiningday on March 20 with Paid Warm Up on March 19.

The traditional Whitsun show is scheduled for June 3 to 5. The ARHA Challenge will follow on May 13-15 and June 17-19, and another NRHA / ARHA show on August 4-7. The highlights will be the Austrian Reining Futurity and the ARHA Maturity, of course.

The \$ 80,000-added Austrian Reining Futurity and NRHA Show will take place from August 17 to 20. The reining highlight has been one of the international top 25 reining events for years. The Austrian Futurity for 3 and 4 year olds is open to all horses and will be held in Open and Non Pro in four levels each. All classes are NRHA approved. In the Futurity classes, both 3 and 4 year old horses can be shown either on Snaffle Bit or Hackamore with two hands, or single handed on Bit. For the benefit of the Austrian Reining Futurity there will again be a stallion service auction with top-class stallions.

The Austrian Reining Maturity & NRHA Show from September 8 to 11 will conclude the WTC show season. The Austrian Reining Maturity is open to all horses that are 5 years and older. The Open and Non Pro Maturity will be held in four levels each. All classes are NRHA approved.
